

For this TULIP PITCHER project, I have used my MILK & BLOSSOMS pattern with a change in the flower and stem. See below for the changes in the cutting and pattern directions.

CUTTING DIRECTIONS


PITCHER [green print] For (12) pitchers:

- Cut (3) 5 ½" strips. Cut (12) 5 ½" x 8 ¾" [a].
- Cut (1) 2 $\frac{3}{4}$ " strip. Cut (12) 2 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " [b] and (12) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 1" [d].
- Cut (2) 1 3/4" strips. Cut (12) 1 3/4" x 4 1/2" [c].
- Cut (1) 1 1/4" strip. cut (12) 1 1/4" x 1" [e] and (1) 1 1/4" squares [ee].

STEM/LEAF FABRIC [small cream print]

- Cut (2) 3" strips. Cut (24) 3" x 3 1/4" [f].
- Cut (2) 1" strips. Cut (12) 1" x 4" [g].

<u>Same cream fabric is used for the inner border per pattern directions.</u>



TULIP FABRIC [larger dot/heart cream print]

Cut (2) 4" strips. Cut (12) 4" x 5 ½" [aa].

Cut (2) 1 ½" strips. Cut (12) 1 ½" x 2 ½" [bb] and (24) 1 ½" x 2" [cc].

TAN BACKGROUND FABRIC

Follow pattern for background pieces [j] through [m]. There are no changes in that section.

Pattern adjustments start below from [n] to the end of block cutting.

If letter is missing, that means the letter is no longe relevant for this version of the pattern. If letter is cut below and not used for TULIP or LEAF, it is intended for the pitcher [see pattern]. If you see a new letter, refer to the diagrams here for the TULIP/LEAF sections to see where it goes and use SEW&FLIP method to make the units.

Resume pattern cutting directions for sashing & borders.

- Cut (3) 2" strips. Cut into (12) 2" squares [n], (12) 2" x 1 1/4" [o] and (24) 2" squares [ss].
- Cut (9) 1 ½" strips. Cut into (24) 1 ½" x 5" [p], (12) 1 ½" squares [q], (12) 1 ½" x 1 ¾" [r] and (120) 1 ½" squares [s]. Note that [n], [o] [q], [r], some [s] & [x] below are needed for the pitcher.
- Cut (7) 1" strips. Cut into (24) 1" x 3" [t], (48) 1" x 3 34" [v] and (12) 1" squares [x]. Same tan fabric is used for outer borders per pattern directions.

PIECING DIRECTIONS

TULIP

Assemble the TULIP at right instead of the original flower. TULIP is made with SEW&FLIP METHOD same as rest of the pattern. TULIP consists of 3 separate units as shown, all using SEW& FLIP.

LEAF/STEM

Use the diagrams in the pattern with the cut sizes provided here. Basically the leaves are bigger and sides are adjusted in this version but the assembly is the same.

PITCHER & QUILT ASSEMBLY

Follow the pattern exactly for the PITCHER assembly as well as the overall quilt assembly.

IMPORTANT NOTE FOR FINAL BLOCK SIZE: TRIM UP THE BOTTOM OF THE PITCHER FOR A 7 ½" X 17 ¾" FINAL BLOCK SIZE [uf].
