Lucky Shamrock Block

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS [per block] 6" x 6" block finished • 6 ½" x 6 ½" unfinished

From <u>each</u> of (6) green prints [the more variety the better]:

Cut (1) 4" square and cut it in ½ on the diagonal to yield (2) triangles [a] from each fabric. This yields enough triangles for 6 leaves/ 2 shamrock blocks but we are cutting this many for lovely scrappy variety!

From (1) solid/tone on tone green print:

Cut (1) 3 ½" x 3 ½" square [b].

From cream print(s) [all from one or scrappy prints]:

Cut (2) 3 1/8" x 3 1/8" squares [c] & (9) 1 1/4" x 1 1/4" squares [d].


PIECING INSTRUCTIONS

Step 1: Using various triangles [a], make half square triangles. Press open. Trim to 3 ½" square.

Make (3) squares, using (2) different green prints for each.

Step 2: Using the SEW & FLIP method, add a square [d] to (3) corners of each leaf unit. Sew, trim and press out. Pay attention to the direction of middle leaf seam.

Step 3: Using the SEW & FLIP method, add a square [c] to top right corner of square [b]. Sew, trim and press out. Add another [c] to the bottom left corner of [b]. Sew, trim and press out. Make (1) stem unit.



Make as many blocks as desired.
