## BLOCKHEADS 5: FIG TREE SETTING PATTERN

## INTRODUCTION

Please refer to BLOCKHEAD blog posts mentioned throughout the full program in terms of numbers of blocks, block instruction sources, sashing print choices etc.

## **CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS**

**FROM SCRAPPY SASHING FABRIC** [variety of ivory, off-white prints w/ delicate red & green accents]: Cut (24) 3 ½" x 12 ½" sashing [a].

FROM POST FABRIC [small cream print w/ red accents]: Cut (12) 3 ½" squares [b].

**FROM BLOCK SASHING** [ivory solid or Fig Tree EYELET white on white or EYELET with tan dots]: Cut (8) 4 ½" x 6 ½" [c] and (16) 1 ½" x 6 ½" [d].

**FROM BORDER FABRIC** [small cream with red or red/green accents]: Cut (8) 3 ½" strips. Piece for length. Cut (2) 3 ½" x 60 ½" L/R borders and (2) 3 ½" x 66 ½" T/B borders.


## PIECING INSTRUCTIONS

**Step 1**: Join the (9) 12" blocks into your center. Alternate with sashing [a] as shown. Press toward [a]. Alternate block rows with (4) sashing [a/b] rows. Press toward sashing rows.

**Step 2:** Join 6" blocks into (4) border rows. Alternate with [c/d] as shown. Press toward [c/d].

**Step 3:** Join a border row to the top and bottom of your center panel. Press open.

**Step 4:** Join final (2) border rows with remaining sashing/post [a/b] as shown. Press open. Add 9" blocks to the top and bottom of each side. Add the sides to the center quilt. Press open.



**Step 5:** Add L/R borders. Press out. Add T/B border. Press out.

**Step 6:** Quilt as desired.

**Step 7:** Bind using (7) 2 1/4" binding strips.

Final Quilt Size: 66  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 66  $\frac{1}{2}$ "
