SPECIAL "HEART BLOCK" ADDITION TO THE SEASONAL PATCHWORK PATTERN

INTRODUCTION

- For this VALENTINE'S HEARTS version we are using the CHRISTMAS version/layout of the pattern.
- For each large tree block, sub the large heart block.
- For each small double tree block sub the small double heart block.
- To make the hearts, use our favorite SEW&FLIP method with the red [A/F] and the small ivory solid squares indicated in the cutting instructions below.
- For the patchwork pieces, use the same variety of cream prints as you would in any of the other versions of this pattern.
- For the original star blocks, we kept the blocks the same, but changed their color to tan so that they would recede into the background a bit more and let the hearts be the stars of the show! We also turned some of the star blocks 90 degrees so that the stars would fall in a slightly different spot, not touching the new heart blocks. Use your best judgement with the placement. See layout below.

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

For each LARGE HEART BLOCK [in place of single TREE block]:

- From any RED PRINT: Cut (2) $3" \times 5 \frac{1}{2}"$ [A].
- From IVORY SOLID: Cut (4) 1 1/4" squares [B] and (2) 2 3/4" squares [C].
- From variety of cream prints for PATCHWORK: Cut (4) 2 ½" x 3 ½" [D] and (2) 3" x 3 ½" [E].

For each SMALL HEARTS BLOCK [in place of double TREE block]:

- From any RED PRINT: Cut (4) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" [F].
- From IVORY SOLID: Cut (8) 1" squares [G] and (4) 2 1/4" squares [H].
- From variety of cream prints for PATCHWORK: Cut (2) 1 ½" x 4 ½" [I] and (4) 2 ½" x 3 ½" [J].
