

Honeybun Pumpkins

Week #2 Assignment

INTRODUCTION

This week we are making the next set of pumpkins, (4) TALL & SKINNY PUMPKINS. These are made in exactly the same way as the LARGE PUMPKINS but are skinnier in width.

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS: TALL & SKINNY PUMPKINS

For each pumpkin choose or cut 2 coordinating 1 ½" strips. We chose (4) pairs of cream print strips.

From each of (8) pumpkin fabrics:

- Cut (3) 1 ½" x 8 ½" [a]

From (1) grey print 1 ½" strip:

- Use (4) [e] pieces cut last month from the grey strip.

From background fabric:

- Cut (1) 2 ½" strip. Cut (8) 2 ½" x 3" [b].
- Cut (1) 1 ½" strip. Cut (16) 1 ½" [c] and (4) 1 ½" x 1 ¼" [d].

PIECING INSTRUCTIONS

Step 1: Join (6) [a] strips together, alternating your 2 chosen prints. Press open or in one direction. Make (4) sets, Unit #1.

PIECING TIP: Unit #1 should measure 8 ½" x 6 ½". If it does not measure that on your first one, make sure you are sewing with an accurate seam allowance and pressing your strips completely open.

Step 2: Using the SEW & FLIP method, add [c] square to each of the (4) corners as shown. Press out.

Step 3: Add [d] to the top of stem. Press toward stem. Add [b] to both sides of stem as shown. Press toward [b]. Make (4) Unit #2.

Step 4: Join Unit #1 and #2 as shown for the (4) cream pumpkins.

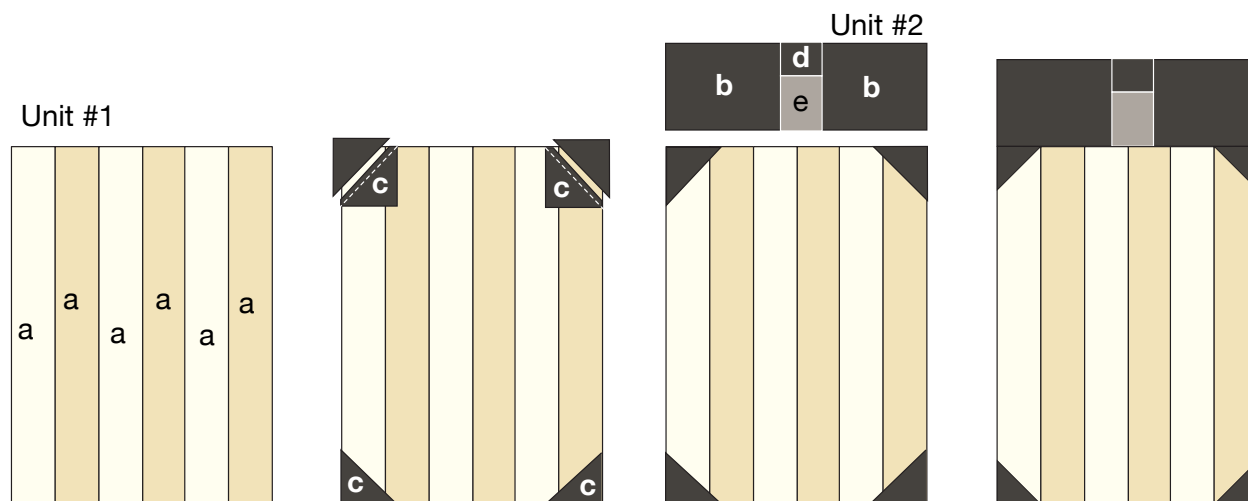


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
