

Valentine's Mystery Sew Along: Week #1

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

♥ From your MAIN red block fabric:

From red print [or a mix of red prints if you want to go scrappy*]:

Cut (2) 6 1/2" strips. Cut (22) 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles [a].

Cut (1) 3 1/2" strip. Cut (4) more 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles [a] for (26) total pieces [a].

***NOTE:** You will need (26) total [a] rectangles to create (13) heart blocks, so be sure to have an equal amount of "pairs" if you are mixing your red prints.

♥ From your MAIN block background fabrics:

From **each** of (6) cream prints [soft, low volumes]:

Cut (1) 3 1/2" strip. Cut (5) 3 1/2" squares [b]*. Save the remainder of the strip for future week.

Cut (1) 1 1/2" strip. Cut (9) 1 1/2" squares [c]*.

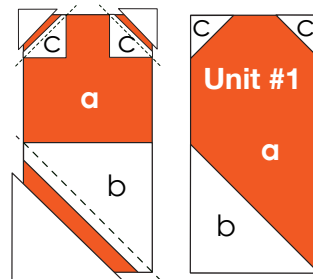
***NOTE:** Due to the scrappy nature of this pattern, you will have a few extra of each of these cut pieces to mix and match to your preference.

HEART PIECING INSTRUCTIONS

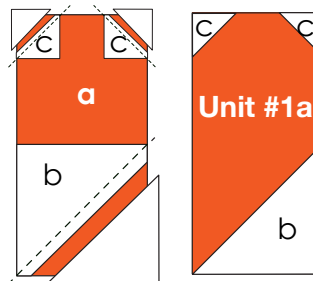
♥ **Step 1:** Using [a/b/c] and the SEW & FLIP method, add (1) square [b] to the bottom left corner of [a] as shown.

Add (2) [c] squares to both top corners as shown.

Make (1) Unit #1 per block. Press out.



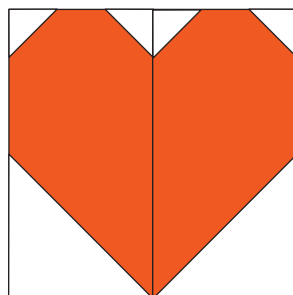
♥ **Step 2:** Repeat the same process as in Step 1 to make (1) mirror image, Unit #1a for the other side of the heart.



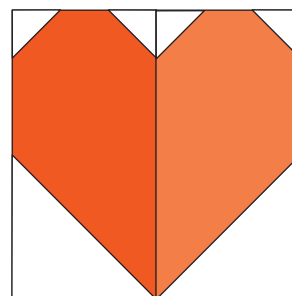
♥ **Step 3:** Join Unit #1 and Unit #1a to create your heart shape. Press open.

If using (2) coordinating prints, your hearts will show with two halves.

Make (13) hearts.
